



Connecticut Mission of Mercy (CTMOM) Free Dental Clinic

Connecticut Mission of Mercy, often referred to as CTMOM, is a free, two-day dental clinic that provides free dental care to under-served and uninsured Connecticut residents. Access to dental care is imperative to maintaining good overall health and CTMOM has been providing free dental care to those that would otherwise go without for more than 10 years.

In 2018, the CTMOM dental clinic provided free dental care to more than 700 patients and donated more than \$500,000 in dental services.

The Connecticut Foundation for Dental Outreach (CFDO) in collaboration with the Connecticut State Dental Association (CSDA) began offering free dental care through the Mission of Mercy project in 2008.
